## When I am 50

### **Please bring the following common supplies with you:**

1. Paintbrushes in the following sizes;
  - 1 x ½-1 inch sized flat or square brush for applying mediums
  - 1 x ½-1 inch sized flat or square brush for applying acrylic paints
  - 1 x ¼ inch sized flat or square brush for acrylic painting
  - 1 x ½ inch sized flat or square brush for acrylic painting
  - Any other small brush you feel comfortable using
2. Heat tool\*
3. Water container for your paint brushes
4. Work surface eg. Ranger Non Stick Craft Sheet or craft cutting mat
5. Small water atomizer
6. Old cloth or rag for cleaning brushes on the go
7. A small palette (old plastic ice cream lid works!)
8. You may also bring along an assortment of paint markers such as fine point sharpie, charcoal pencils (soft variety) or white gel pens

### **Supplied in class fee:**

- Acrylic inks for shared use
- Gesso for shared use
- Matte Medium for shared use
- Dylusions paint assortment for shared use
- Manilla inserts for jounalling
- Class handouts including images for journaling

### **Optional**

Feel free to bring your own journal to paint in if you have one!

\*It is highly preferable everyone has their own heat tool for use during class as this will help keep class time on track and for you to get the most out of the class instead of waiting for paint to dry. Please organise to borrow one from a friend if you don't own one or you can use a hair dryer instead.
